Materials List

Students should bring:

- o 1 jar or container to hold water for rinsing brushes
- o 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 water spray bottle
- Watercolor paper, 140 pound (Arches or Fabriano is the best choice) approximately 5x7" or 11x 15"
- Watercolor brushes, various sizes 1 -2" flats are good to have
- Watercolors in tubes (not pans)
- A china plate or watercolor palette
- 1 backing board 12 x 16" it may be plywood, masonite, a firm surface to tape down our paintings to prevent buckling of the paper

Ms. Marshall will supply rice paper, nori glue, artist tape, brayers.
